


1. Make the sign of the cross, kiss the crucifix and pray the Apostle's Creed.

 5. State and contemplate the first Mystery and the grace you are praying for in this particular Mystery then pray the Our Father.
 6. Pray 10 Hail Marys.
 7. Pray the Glory be and the Fatima prayer.
- The next bead will start the next Mystery so repeat steps 5-7 and continue for all the Mysteries.
8. Conclude with the Hail Holy Queen then the Conclusion.
